The Business End Tour

Day 1 Friday 14th October

Arrive in Auckland and be transferred to your hotel. Afternoon free to explore Auckland city.

Day 2 Saturday 15th October - GAME DAY

Morning free. Afternoon transfer to Eden Park for semi-final 1.

Day 3 Sunday 16th October - GAME DAY

Morning free. Afternoon transfer to Eden Park for semi-final 2.

Day 4 Monday 17th October

This morning, leave Auckland for the Bay of Islands. Heading north, cross over the Harbour Bridge and travel through Auckland's North Shore suburbs, before reaching the beautiful beaches of the Hibiscus Coast. Continue to Brynderwyn, turn westward onto State Highway 12 and travel to Matakoho. Here visit the Otamatea Kauri and Pioneer Museum to discover the story of the magnificent kauri tree, its timber and gum. Continue to the township of Dargaville and the Waipoua Forest, the highlight of a west coast visit. This superb forest sanctuary is the largest remnant of a once extensive Kauri forest. Check into the hotel in the Bay of Islands for 3 nights.

Day 40 Tuesday 18th October

Full day tour in the Bay of Islands including visiting the stone house at Keri Keri, Waitangi Treaty House and a cruise through the hole in the rock. Enjoy a visit to the Waitangi Treaty House and Grounds. The Treaty of Waitangi, signed in 1840 between Maori Chiefs and the British Crown, became the basis for life in New Zealand as it is known today. See the historic Treaty House, a fully carved Maori Meeting House, Maori War Canoe and enjoy the extensive grounds.

Day 41 Wednesday 19th October

Free day in the Bay of Islands. Recommended is the Full Day Cape Reinga Tour (optional). This is a tour for those who wish to spend time enjoying the magnificent natural wonders of the North. Be over-awed by the grandeur of the mighty Kauri trees, the expanse of Ninety Mile Beach and the mystique of Cape Reinga. There are numerous stops to take in the scenic highlights and activities. Lunch is included during the tour today.

Day 42 Thursday 20th October

Today leave the delightful Bay of Islands and travel to Auckland. Tonight enjoy the Total Sports Travel dinner hosted by Rugby celebrities.

Day 43 Friday 21st October - GAME DAY

Free day to join in all Rugby World Cup 2011 activities down at the Viaduct. Evening transfer to the Bronze Final.

Day 44 Saturday 22nd October

Day at leisure. Why not catch the ferry to Devonport for a seafood lunch or take in an optional tour?
